## **6.) Code of Conduct, Sensitivity Training, etc**

- attempt to get legislative framework done this year
- sensitivity training for council

Steve made a motion that Hooper Council should go through sensitivity training - Stef seconded Motion passes Motion made to accept these ideas as framework and general Hooper mindset

Rachael O'Leary's comments: don't focus on problems because progress will be limited. Instead, focus on the future. Also, contact the Speak Up program (dean of students) and Diversity specialists with the Vice Chancellor of student affairs office for help.
